

Dear Parents

As you are aware all our schools close for 'business as normal' tonight. From Monday we can only offer supervision to identified students to support the government drive on 'social distancing.' Therefore, students **MUST NOT** come into school unless we have been in contact with yourselves and been able to confirm that we can offer supervision to your child. The school day will start at 9.30 a.m. and finish at 2.00p.m. Students should attend in their school uniform. If they are entitled to a Free School Meal this will be provided. For all other students, they should bring a packed lunch as we will not have an on-site meal service.

For all students, school work to be completed during the next two weeks can be found on the web site of our school and for those students still dual registered with their mainstream school, they can access on line learning modules. Physical work packs have also been provided, and delivered by staff today.

For those students who are entitled to Free School Meals and not in the above category, their mainstream school will be sending you a voucher – this is for students who may also be permanently excluded.

As you can appreciate the support we can provide may change as the next two weeks progress, dependent upon the number of staff that will continue to be fit to work. I hope we can continue to work in partnership to support these arrangements.
